




Available for shoots in the Museum with crews of 6 +. Visitor toilets in the Park

Green Room




Domestic supply only in the Museum and Orangery


No restrictions. Positions must be agreed in advance



24/7 access to the Park. All shoots in the Museum must be supervised. Combi codes required for disabled car park (outside of 9am - 5pm) and for the unit base

Access



Crews must arrange waste disposal. Any waste must be removed from site by the end of booking

Huge unit base available. For larger shoots, technical vehicles can be parked in the courtyard, disabled and staff car parks next to the Museum and crew cars in an overflow field (trackway may be required)

Food can be consumed in the green room spaces only

Catering

The Museum is open to the public Tuesday to Sunday, 10am-4.30pm.

Shoots requiring the Museum to be completely closed to the public require a lead in time of 1 month.

Location Conditions

- Open entrances must be manned at all times.
- Crew, vehicles, ez-up tents or other equipment must not block fire exits.
- Hot food and drink may not be consumed in interior locations except green rooms.
- All cables must be covered.
- Floor protection must be used in interior locations.
- No fixtures, hangings or adhesives on walls, frames or doorways except on selected existing hooks in the Drawing Room (weight limits apply – Hook Weight Test Report can be supplied).
- Placing items on mantelpieces is not permitted.
- Painting is not permitted. Paint colours are listed below.
- Chandelier light bulbs can be swapped for period ones.
- Dust, powders, glitter and candles are not permitted.
- High heeled shoes must have heel caps.
- Stanchions should be kept in place.
- Furniture must be lifted, not dragged.
- Weight limit on the Terrace of approximately 3,500kg.
- Lighting must be kept away from combustible materials and fragile surfaces.
- Hazers, smoke machines, steamers hairspray etc must not be used near walls or heritage items. Windows must be kept open for the duration. With permission only.
- Equipment must not be placed in flower beds or within 5m of tree roots.
- Generator positions must be agreed in advance.
- Pond access is permitted. With permission only.
- Staking, pegging and drilling in the ground is not permitted.
- 5mph speed limit throughout the site.

Rates

Due to Gunnersbury Park & Museum's status as a charity and extremely busy calendar, we regret that only commercial applications are considered, regardless of the scale and location. As such, **we are unable to accept proposals from students or charities** that cannot match the **minimum rates** below:

- **Museum** – £1,500 + VAT per day
- **Orangery** – £1,000 + VAT per day
- **Park only** – £750 + VAT per day

Exact **rates are calculated based on the type of and needs of the production**. We take into consideration the following factors:

- Total amount of people on site (including artists, agency, contributors, entourage etc)
- Amount of time on site (including estimated prep. / strike time and hold days)
- Location(s) required (for shoots in the Museum, which rooms)
- Scale of equipment (ie. drones, cranes, generators)
- Level of exclusivity or closure required
- Parking requirements (ie. unit base, tech vehicles, caterers, crew cars)
- Additional spaces required (ie. for green rooms, catering, crew/crowd holding, video village)
- Budget (your maximum budget for this location)
- Type of production (ie. studio vs independent feature, HETV vs unscripted comedy, luxury brand vs independent shop)

To receive a quote, **please email your requirements to gunnersbury@filmfixer.co.uk**. We will provide you with an initial, estimated quote to be used as a guideline. Once we receive your application and final proposal, we will supply a final quote along with the **costs of any staffing required to supervise your hire**. For site activity before 9am and after 5pm, double time is charged for staffing costs.

Our dedicated **unit base space is charged at a flat rate of £1,500 per 24 hours** (charged pro rata).

We also **charge an administration fee of £75 + VAT per hour of processing time**. Each booking will require a different amount of processing depending on requirements and changes. An estimated guide is as follows:

- Studio feature / HETV in the Museum: 6-10 hours
- Photo shoot in the Museum: 4-6 hours
- Studio feature / HETV in the Park: 4-6 hours
- Photo shoot in the Park: 2-4 hours
- Unit base only: 1 hour

All rates quoted are subject to VAT. Refundable damage deposits are taken for all bookings.

Non-refundable holding deposits are taken for larger scale or longer length bookings. Cleared payment is required before the start of all bookings. **Public liability insurance of a minimum of £5 million** is required for all bookings (drones, significant set dressing, special effects etc may require £10 million +).






