

Introduction

Potters Fields Park is a 2.5-acre iconic riverside setting with a fantastic view of Tower Bridge, the Thames and the City's skyline in the distance. The Park is located next to the former City Hall, More London and The Scoop. The location is privately managed by the Potters Fields Park Management Trust.

The Blueprint Cafe, at 28 Shad Thames, is located a short walk away and can function as a green room space as well as provide toilet access.



Technical Specifications

The location is bordered by residential properties and as such shoots are not permitted between 11pm - 7am (10pm - 7am on Sunday nights)

The flying of drones is strictly prohibited on or over the Park at any time, in accordance with byelaws.



The Blueprint Cafe at 28 Shad Thames (0.5 miles; 4 min drive / 7 min walk - see pages 8 & 9) and is available for green room space-hired through FilmFixer



No toilets on site. Honey wagons / 'Portaloo's' may be positioned on site with permission. Otherwise, toilets are located at the Blueprint Cafe



63 amp three-phase supply available (hidden in the ground at the south side of Lawn 3)



Battery or green fuel generators preferred. Quiet, diesel generators as a last resort For access, see page 7



No supply on site. Supply available in Blueprint Cafe

Dining is permitted in Blueprint Cafe at 28 Shad Thames



Vehicle access is limited to Luton van size via Potters Fields (Lane). Two banksmen required. Trackway required if vehicles are to traverse the Vehicle Movement grass. Site visit with PFP and key required from PFP offices



On street council parking bay suspensions can be applied for via Southwark Film Office operated by Film Fixer



24/7 public access to the Park

Crews must arrange waste disposal. Any waste must be removed from site

APPLICATION TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Crew size should include cast, models, artists, presenters, contributors, chaperones and agency.
- Admin fees are calculated per hour of administrative time. The figures quoted are a minimum charge and may be multiplied accordingly for intensive applications.
- Students must provide proof to be eligible for discounted rates. "Micro-budget Indies" are classed as low or no-budget, non-commercial productions (ie. unfunded films, personal portfolios, non-profit social media shoots etc) and small local charities.
- Charities producing content in-house (without contracting an agency) may be eligible for discounts please email your brief to obtain a quote.
- All cables must be covered with cable mats, even on the grass.
- All trees must be safeguarded throughout the booking. An Arboriculture Statement and Tree Protection Plan (2021) is available on request. Extreme care must also be taken to protect nesting birds in trees and hedges during the nesting season (March-August).
- Repairs and reinstatement will normally be charged at cost plus 10%. For major damage, an estimate of the costs will be provided, and all repairs will be carried out under the instruction of an approved contractor.
- Any accidents involving members of the public, staff or contractors must be recorded in the owner's Accident Book.
- For all applications, payment must be made before the shoot. Payment can be made by card online, or by BACS with proof of payment or remittance. Please be aware that some charges may still apply to cancelled applications if already processed.
- You must have Public Liability Insurance with a minimum cover of £5 million in order to gain a licence to shoot.
- Security deposits may be requested for large-scale shoots or if any alterations are granted. If terms and conditions are not adhered to, the security deposit may not be returned.
- Additional terms and conditions may be introduced when further requests are able to be implemented.
