Maas Gallery is an independent fine art gallery located in St James's, London and very close to Mayfair and The Mall. The gallery is open to small shoots, documentaries but also larger takeovers for crowd, make up and costume spaces if filming nearby. The gallery could also be dressed as a shop and has a stunning shop window on an iconic London street. The owners are very film friendly meaning that all paintings and pictures can be removed.

NB: There are steps down from street level (however the owners can borrow a ramp from a nearby business). There is no lift to the basement floor.




Toilets

Located downstairs in the gallery. No lift or step free access




Green Room

Two spaces available in the gallery space and could be used for crowd holding or changing




Electricity

Domestic supply only throughout the gallery

Nearest FilmFixer managed Unit Base is Lincoln Inn Fields (15 mins travel time)




Vehicle Movement

No restrictions – for anything outside on the street please contact Westminster Filming & Events Team

Food can be consumed onsite



Waste Disposal

Crews must arrange waste disposal. Any waste must be removed from site by the end of booking

Normal opening hours for the gallery are Monday to Friday 10.00 – 17.30. The Gallery is closed on Saturdays & Sundays.





Location Conditions & Rates

- Open entrances must be always be manned. (including the basement emergency exit if used). CCTV is in operation throughout the gallery.
- Hot food and drink may be consumed.
- Floor protection must be used throughout this location.
- Prior art department intensions required in advance for the changing or removal of any paintings and photographs.
- Dust, powders, glitter and candles are not permitted.
- High heeled shoes must have heel caps.
- Furniture must be lifted, not dragged.
- Lighting must be kept away from combustible materials and fragile surfaces.
- All lighting stands must be covered with feet protectors.
- Hazers, smoke machines, steamers hairspray etc. must not be used without prior permission. Windows & Doors must be kept open for the duration. With permission only.

To receive a quote, **please email your requirements to locations@filmfixer.co.uk**. We will provide you with an initial, estimated quote to be used as a guideline. Once we receive your application and final proposal, we will supply a final quote along with the **costs of any staffing required to supervise your hire**. For site activity before 10am and after 5.30pm, double time is charged for staffing costs.

We also **charge an administration fee of £75 + VAT per hour of processing time**. Each booking will require a different amount of processing depending on requirements and changes.


All rates quoted are subject to VAT. Refundable damage deposits are taken for all bookings. Non-refundable holding deposits are taken for larger scale or longer length bookings. Cleared payment is required before the start of all bookings.

Public liability insurance of a minimum of £5 million is required for all bookings (significant set dressing and moving of artwork may require £10 million +).


A member of gallery staff is required on the throughout prep, filming and strike. The cost is £21.50 p/h and chargeable to the production.

Basement Floor Plan


