

St Dunstan's College is an active educational institution in Catford, built in 1888. As it is still functional, **filming** at is only possible during weekends and school holidays; unit bases may be possible outside of these times.

The grounds span across two sites either side of Catford. The Jubilee Ground has a large car park that can house unit bases plus a function suite for green rooms, wardrobe and toilets. On site sports facilities include a swimming pool, a sports hall, a cricket pitch, football and hockey pitches, basketball and badminton courts, a fully equipped gym and a dance studio. The college also has a doctor's surgery, reception desks, changing rooms and kitchens.

Rate Card Terms

- 'Crew size' should include cast, models, artists, presenters, contributors, chaperones and agency.
- Admin fees are calculated per hour of administrative time. The figures quoted are a minimum charge and may be multiplied accordingly for time intensive applications.
- Students and charities must provide proof to be eligible for discounted rates. 'Micro-budget Indies' are classed as low or no-budget, non-commercial productions (ie. unfunded films, personal portfolios, non-profit social media shoots etc).
- Students studying at St. Dunstan's should contact their tutor and will not be required to pay fees nor apply via FilmFixer.
- For all applications, payment must be made before the shoot. Payment can be made by card online, or by BACS with proof of payment or remittance. Please be aware that some charges may still apply to cancelled applications if already processed.
- You must have Public Liability Insurance, with a minimum cover of £5 million, in order to gain a licence to shoot.
- Security deposits are taken for all bookings. If terms and conditions are not adhered to, the security deposit may not be returned.
- Additional terms and conditions may be introduced by St Dunstan's when further requests are able to be implemented.

Technical Specifications

- The site is only available for filming and photography on weekends and during school holidays. Unit base parking may be available on school days
- If students are on site at the time of a shoot, they strictly cannot be filmed or photographed

Toilets available in all areas of the site










