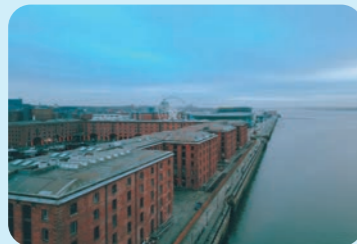

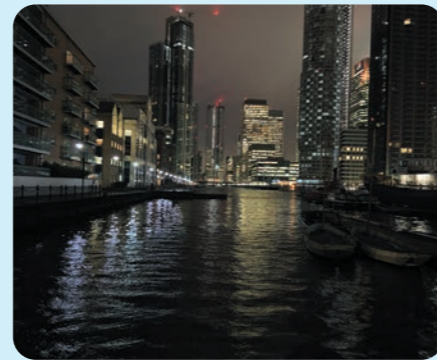
Whether you're looking for historic docks, picturesque rural canals or urban waterside destinations, we can help you find the right location for your production.

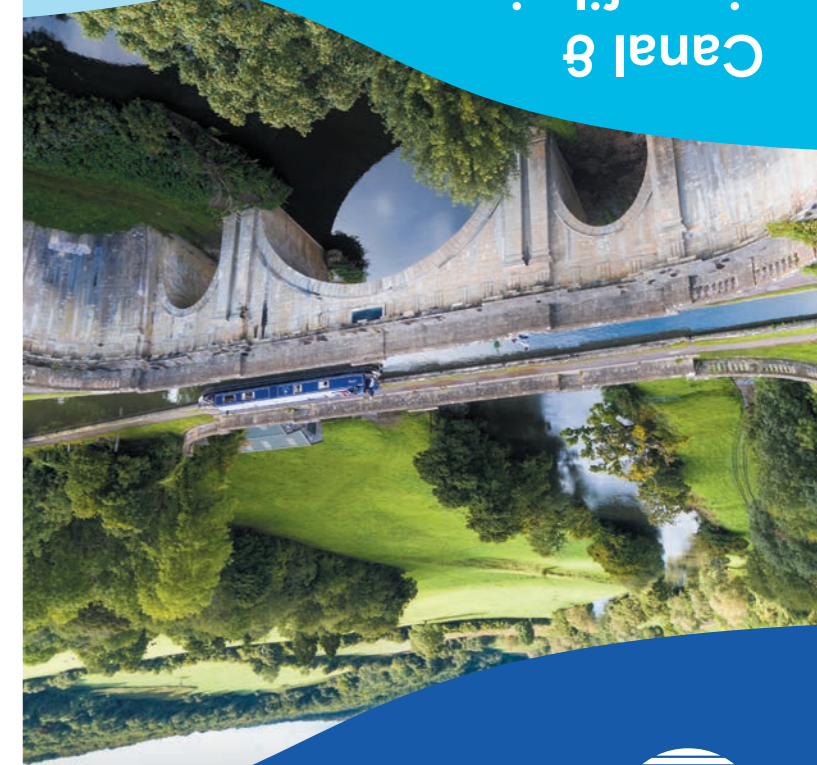
