



Introduction

Chiswick House, a Grade I listed building in West London, is a great example of 18th century British architecture. The third Earl of Burlington, designer of this Neoclassical, Palladian villa drew inspiration from his Grand Tours in Italy.

The **Gardens** are birthplace of the English Landscape Movement and underwent a £12m restoration project which has reinstated the original vistas and repaired the statues and garden buildings.

During its long history, Chiswick House has also been used as an asylum and a fire station, and during World War II it was damaged when a V-2 rocket hit one of the wings.



Technical Specifications



Three-phase power pop-up supplies across the site (additional fees apply).



Single private toilet (next to the Kitchenette green room) included for all shoots. Additional toilets available in the House and Cricket Pavilion when hired. Visitor toilets located next to the Café.



Catering

The Cricket Pavilion or Garden Pavilion can be hired to host catering. The Café is also available for hire and offers hot drinks and food. Large scale productions permitted to erect an additional marquee (additional fees may apply).

Vehicles operate on a one-way

route onsite. Vehicles may operate on hardstanding only. Should vehicles exceeding 7.5T be required, the production must

Unlimited water for bowsers is available from an external tap within the Cherry Orchard (charged per 1000L) - Must be agreed with CHGT prior to usage.



Access to the Cherry Orchard via a key available from the Estate Yard. All other access arrangements are arranged on a case-by-case basis.



All waste must be removed from the site daily.



Parking for under 10 cars is available in the Estate Yard or Forecourt. Parking for over 10 cars can be made available in the Walled Garden and/or Cherry Orchard (please note trackway required). Please advise FilmFixer of your requirements and suitable locations will be proposed.



Green Room

Green rooms and back of house areas are available in some parts of the site. Please advise on requirements and FilmFixer can propose suitable locations. A seasonal Garden Pavilion is erected from April to September which is an ideal green room option.

The sumptuous interiors include three velvet rooms which feature Lord Burlington's fine art collection and decorated ceilings. The Gallery is made up of three connecting rooms, linked by small, arched openings and lead into the Upper Tribune, which has a high domed roof. There are other unique spaces such as a cellar and columned rooms. All the interiors are perfect for a period production.


