CHISWICK HOUSE & GARDENS TRADING





Chiswick House, a Grade I listed building in West London, is a great example of 18th-century British architecture. The third Earl of Burlington, designer of this Neoclassical, Palladian villa, drew inspiration from his Grand Tours in Italy. The Gardens underwent a £12m restoration project which has reinstated the original vistas and repaired the statues and garden buildings.

During its long history, Chiswick House has also been used as an asylum and a fire station, and during World War II it was damaged when a V-2 rocket hit one of the wings.

Shoot Information

Filming and photography is welcomed at Chiswick House and Gardens. The estate has been used for many major productions including **Killing Eve, The Great** and **Pennyworth**. The Grade I listed Conservatory and Gardens famously played host to a number of music videos for **The Beatles** and a live wedding on **Ant & Dec's Saturday Night Takeaway**.

To ensure there is no possibility of damage to the buildings or gardens, as well as to reduce any potential inconvenience to the public, production companies must present detailed plans before approval is granted.

Shoots inside the House are only allowed under certain circumstances. Chiswick House & Gardens Trust work in partnership with **English Heritage** to ensure the building and its contents are preserved for future generations.

Shoots in the Gardens and Conservatory are much easier to arrange. We can issue location agreements with short notice if the filming or photography is small scale, exterior only and does not affect the statues or structures within the Gardens.

The site offers a three-phase power supply and a number of options for unit bases and tech/crew parking. We have several green room spaces and the on-site café can be hired for catering. Full technical details as well as floor plans, rates and other helpful information are available on request.





The sumptuous interiors include three velvet rooms which feature Lord Burlington's fine art collection and decorated ceilings. The Gallery is made up of three connecting rooms, linked by small, arched openings and lead into the Upper Tribune, which has a high domed roof. A spiral staircase leads to an atmospheric, octagonal brick cellar. All the interiors are perfect for a period production.

Please note there are some circumstances in which items loaned to Chiswick House may not be filmed or photographed – these will be identified by on the initial recce.























