

## Fitzroy Square: Filming Guidelines

**Fitzroy Square has experienced a high volume of location filming/shooting which has made it necessary to establish rules. Fitzroy Square residents are keen to ensure that shooting/filming remains within strict guidelines so as not to disturb more than absolutely necessary the peace and harmony in the Square for residents and businesses.**

### RESIDENTIAL AREA

Large scale productions (more than 5 crew) will need at least three weeks before the shoot day. Resident meeting may be required for large shoots.

Productions should distribute a filming proposal letter, approved by the Camden Film Office, to all residents Fitzroy Square.

### HOURS – ACCESS FOR FILMING

Permitted hours are 8am to 8pm with no access before or after these times. No prep or strike can occur outside of these hours. There is no filming/shooting on weekends.

### PARKING – UNIT BASES

Both Russell Square and Lincoln's Inn Field Unit Bases are close to Fitzroy Square.

### PARKING – TECHNICAL VEHICLES

Only essential technical vehicles (usually 3 or less) will be considered for parking suspension in the area.

### SUSPENSIONS

Suspension of resident only parking bays will not be considered.

Pay & Display/Shared Use parking bays for technical vehicles is restricted to specified bays in the area – please see map over.

A recce is recommended.

### PERMITTED EQUIPMENT

No projectors, bright tower lamps, mirrors, or any equipment with the same effect allowed on the Square, (special permission must be sought in exceptional circumstances, by prior agreement with FSF&GC) All cabling needs to run along the rails, be covered and must never be a potential trip hazard.

### GARDEN

There is NO ACCESS to the garden.

### NUMBER OF SHOOTS

The maximum shoot days per annum is 20 days for larger productions; shoots are to be spaced out with at least 1 week between each other.

### MONITORING AGENT

Frontagers require that the film/shoot company pay £250 for a monitoring agent. He/she will be hired by the Frontagers, will be independent from the shoot and will ensure that the present guidelines are adhered to.

### DEPOSIT

A deposit will be taken prior to filming – returnable only if the film crew abides by all guidelines.

### DONATIONS

A donation to Frontages and Garden Committee is welcomed.
