






Cumberland Lodge is a 17<sup>th</sup> century Grade II listed former royal residence in Windsor Great Park. Set within 5,000 acres of beautiful parkland, this historic location has both versatile and regal interiors as well as expansive, majestic exteriors. The Lodge is home to a charity that promotes open dialogue on pressing social issues, supported by residential conference and event bookings. It is noted for its warm hospitality and impressive facilities.

The main Lodge on the property features stunning interior spaces such as a grand staircase, three dining rooms, a tapestry hall, a sitting room, library, drawing room, several bedrooms, multiple corridors, a basement, meeting room, chapel, ante-room and bar. Additionally, the Mews and Groom's House contain 23 en suite bedrooms and a fully-fitted kitchen which are available as guest accommodation. 




























## Exterior Locations
